

CLUB COMMUNICATION CONTEST FOR THE DEAF AND HARD OF HEARING (CCDHH) COMMITTEE

PURPOSE: To promote the Club's participation in the Communications Contest for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing in order to provide opportunity for youth eligible for this Contest.

PERSONNEL: Committee Chair should have a passion about the program and the ability to locate and secure contestants to have a Club level Contest.

DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES:

- To advertise and conduct the CCDHH Contest at the Club level.
- Seek out potential participants from a school specializing in deaf and hard of hearing students and promote the program directly to them.
- To recruit JOOI Club members with an interest in learning rudimentary sign language to act as companions to contestants during Contest.
- After the Club Contest submit the Official Zone/District Entry Form along with a typed version of the presentation to the District CCDHH Chair.
- To complete the CCDHH Evaluation Form.
