

CLUB SERGEANT-AT-ARMS

PURPOSE: To facilitate fun, fellowship and orderly Club meetings.

PERSONNEL: The Sergeant-At-Arms is usually a single appointee, however, 2-3 members may be useful. The Sergeant-at-Arms should be outgoing and enjoy interaction with members.

DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES: Member attendance is an excellent measure of a successful, inviting Sergeant-at-Arms.
